## KARABÜK UNIVERSITY 2014-2015 ACADEMIC YEAR FOREIGN STUDENT PREFERENCE NOTICE

Application requirements for students who would like to study at Karabük University in 2014-2015 academic year:

- 1. Getting 50 points and above in the International Student Admission Exam of Universities Association of Western Black Sea.
- 2. Getting a result in a specified degree in the exams having international validity.
- 3. The foreign students will also be placed according to the result of their high school diploma after the finalization of the process of placement according to YOGS and BKUBUOKS as well as according to the result of internationally recognized tests seen on table 1 below if the quotas for each programme are not fully filled in.

NOTE: the exams that have been made for foreign students by other universities will not be accepted.

## A) APPLICATION PROCEDURES

- 1. The students having the requirements stated above will apply on the website of Department of Student Affairs of Karabük University between 25 July 2014 and 11 August 2014.
- 2. Preference Notification Form must be filled carefully and online.
- 3. Foreign student candidate may apply to maximum 5 programs that confer on diploma at Karabük University. (Candidates cannot make more than 5 preferences.)
- 4. After the Preference Form is filled online, application procedure is made in person or by mail with the following documents to the Department of Student Affairs (Foreign Students Office).
- 5. Candidates must send a notarized and/or consulate approved sample of exam result belonging to any Country National/ International exams which will be used in the determination of placement scores in person or by mail to the Department of Student Affairs (Foreign Students Office) until the end of working hour on 11 August 2014 which is stated in foreign students' application, exam and registration calendar and the last day of being reported of preference procedures.
- 6. Arrival date of application documents to university is considered. Karabük University is not responsible for the delays caused by mail. If the documents required for the application are lacking, the application of candidate will not be evaluated.

## B) REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

- 1. A notarized and/or consulate approved sample of high school diploma and/or graduation certificate.
- 2. A sample of passport and/or identity received from public authority.

- 3. If there is, a notarized and/or consulate approved sample of exam result belonging to any Country National/ International exams.
- 4. 2 passport standard photos taken in the last six months.
